

WILL OF
WILLIAM RUTHERFORD.

In the State of South Carolina Newberry District.

In the Name of God Amen I William Rutherford of the state and District aforesaid being at this time weak of body but of sound mind memory and Understanding thanks be given unto god for the same calling unto mind the Mortallity of my body well knowing it appointed once for all men to die do make this my Last will and Testament and dispose of all my worldly goods in the following manner and form Viz

Item 1 my will and desire that should I die in this state my body be buried with out much ceremony near the Charleston Roads on the North side from where my Mother and Father are buried a place where I have shewn Burwell Liles that a head and foot stone be placed at my Grave and the grave walled in with or brick friends either Rock or wood twelve feet square that my friends may now where I am buried

Item 2 My will and desire that all my Just Debts be paid by my executors as soon as posseable out of the first money that shall come into their hands out the sales or either wise of my Estate

Item 3 I give and bequeath Unto my Son Thomas B Rutherford all my bearing apparrell Except my silver Watch the seal with the two first Letters of my name there on he is to have also give him my Negro man George

Item 4 I give and bequeath Unto my friend John Casey Son of General Levy Casey now Decast my silver Watch whitch I got from the said General Casey as a Token of Respect for the Familye the said John Casey he deed them to go to his Eldest son

Item 5 I lend to Nancy Lane Son during her Natural Lifetime one Tract of Land adjoining where she now Lives (Peter Rapp Sams)

Testament and dispose of all my worldly goods in the following manner and form viz

Item 1 My will and desire that should I die in this state my body be buried with out much ceremony near the Charleston road on the North side from where my Mother and Father is buried a place where I have shewn Burwell Liles that a head and foot stone be placed at my grave and the grave walled in with or brick either Rock or ~~Brick~~ twelve feet square that my friends may now where I am buried

Item 2 My will and desire that all my just debts be paid by my executors as soon as possible out of the first money that shall come into their hands out the sales or either wise of my estate

Item 3 I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas B Rutherford all my earing apparrell Except my silver watch the seal with the two first letters of my name there on he is to have also give him my Negro man George

Item 4 I give and bequeath unto my friend John Casey Son of General Levy Casey now Deacon my silver watch whitch I got from the said General Casey as a Token of Respect for the Family and the said John Casey be dead them to go to his eldest son

Item 5 I lend to Nancy Lane Sen. during her Natural Lifetime one Tract of Land adjoining where she now lives (Peter Rapp Schenck David Litsey and Michael Cromer) and after her death to be sold at two years credit and the money arising there from to be Divided as I shall Direct the Rest of my Estate to be

Item 6 The balance of my property both Real and Person I will and bequeath in the following manner that my Lands be sold at one two and three years with Interest from the date that is a credit of that time the Negroes at two years credit that is one and two with Interest same Manner. Taking Notes with two

ecutors and a Mortgage to secure punctual payment the balance of the property to be sold on a credit of one year with out interest

Item 7 My will and desire is that after all my debts are paid the balance from the sale of all my Estate left to be sold both real and personal I desire to be devided in the following Manner Viz I freely Give and bequeath Unto the three Illegitimate Children of Nancy Lane Senr Namely William R Lane Harriet Frances Epting now wife of Henry Epting and Nancy Jane Lane one fourth part of the whole of the property sold belonging to my Estate after all my debts are paid to be devided in this way Nancy Jane Lane is to be first paid one hundred and twenty dollars and the balance to be Equally Devided between them three share and share alike the shares of Harriett and Nancy should they have Husbands their Husbands is to have no Clame or Controle over their Devidends but to them the said gave Absoluteley to manage as they see cause

Item 8 the Other three fourth I will and bequeath to be devided as Followeth Viz one half to my son Thomas B Rutherford should he be living if dead to be Devided Equally among his heirs the other half of the three fourths to be Equally devided between the Two Sons of my Son John Deseast should they be living of either should be dead then to the other if both shall be dead before they come of Age say twenty one I give them part or portion to Thomas B Rutherford or his heirs that shall be then living

Item 9 My will and desire that my Executors or Either keep in Charge the devidend bequeathed to the two sons of John Deseast and William Until they shall be come of full Age allowing

Children of Nancy Lane Senr Namely William R Lane Harriet
Frances Epping now wife of Henry Epping and Nancy Jane Lane one
fourth part of the whole of the property sold belonging to my
estate after all my debts are paid to be devided in this way
Nancy Jane Lane is to be first paid one hundred and twenty
Dollars and the balance to be Equally Devided between them three
more and share alike the shares of Harriett and Nancy should
they have Husbands their Husbands is to have no Clam or Con-
trole over their Devidends but to them the said gave Absoluteley
to manage as they see cause

Item 8 the Other three fourth I will and bequeath to be devided
as Followeth Viz one half to my son Thomas B Rutherford should
he be Living if dead to be Devided Equally among his heirs the
other half of the three fourths to be Equally devided between
the Two Sons of my Son John Descaast should they be Living or
either should be dead then to the other if both shall be dead
before they come of Age say twenty one I give them part or
portion to Thomas B Rutherford or his heirs that shall be then
Living

Item 9 My will and desire that my Executors or either keepin
in charge the devidend bequeathed to the two sons of John
Antine and William Untill they shall be come of full Age allowing
them or their Guardian the lawful Interest

Item 10 And Lastly I do nominate and appoint My son Thomas B
Rutherford and my Nephew Drayton Nance Executors to this my Last
Will and Testament Revoking all former Wills by me made Abounding
this to be my last will and Testament and No other in witness
whereof I have Unto Set my hand and fix my seal in presence of U
us February 7 -- 1842
