Item First of all it is my Will and I hereby Order that my Funeral Expences and all my Just Debts be Timely and Punctually Paid Out of my Personal Estate before any Division or other Distribution be made thereof

2-- I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary Turner One bay Mare that goes by the Name of Moll and her Saddle and the Plantation where I now live On During her Natural life or Widow hood without Interruption,

3-- I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son William Turner One Acre of Land to be laid off to him in the North Corner of my Tract of land

4-- It is my Will and I do hereby order that after my beloved Wife Desese I have my Estate to be sold both Real and Personal and to be Equly Divided between my Children William Turner Rebecke Turner Rhoda, Turner Edward Turner Absolom Turner David Turner Susanah Turner An Turner If any One of ~~thaxam~~ my Children Should Dy before the Should Com to the years of Maturety that their part should fall to the Youngest of my Children -----

Lastly I hereby Nominate and appount my Trustee and well beloved Wife Mary Turner and my well beloved Friend Mercer Babb Sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament Retifying & Confirming this & no other to be my last Will hereby Revoking and Difanuling all former and other wills by me made or Suffered to be made In Witnesses Thereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this thirtyeth Day of December One thousand Seven Hundred & Eighty Nine -----
