William White of the above named State and District Being of  
sound and disposing memory and mind but weak in bodily health  
and calling to mind the uncertainty of life fell desirous to  
dispose of all my worldly estate such as God has been pleased to  
bless me with do make and ordain this my last will viz that is  
to say in the manner following

I will that all my just debts and funerall expences shall be  
paid out of my Estate in the first instance and after that I  
will to my wife Frances White all the remaining portion of my  
Estate during her natural life consisting of the tract of land  
where on I now live Horses Hogs Cattle Household and Kitchen  
Furniture Plantation Tools and every other article of property  
not mentioned I will that my Son William G White shall not  
receive any portion of my Estate untill the rest of my Children  
are made equal with what he has received And lastly I do appoint  
and ordain my wife Frances White and my Son William White  
Executrix and Executor of this my last Will and testament in  
testimony where of I have here unto set my hand and affixed my  
seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 1837
