WILLIAM WHITMIRE.

In the name of God Amen, I William Whitmire
of the District and State aforesaid being of sound and disposing
mind and memory and being desirous to dispose of all such
worldly property or estate as it hath pleased God to blesse me
with do make & ordain this my last will, in manner following,
that is to say: I desire that all my just debts shall be paid
out of the monies owing to me: After payment of my just debts
and funeral expences, I give to my ^{wife} Sarah Whitmire all my lands
lying on the North side of Demmons Creek, my negro woman called
Rachel, and one of my horses whichever she may choose, one bed
& furniture and one year's provision, for and during the term
of her natural life; and after her decease, I give the same to
my children hereinafter mentioned, to be equally divided among
them, with the exception of my three youngest children viz.,
Henry Thomas & Jackson whom I desire to ^{have} each one hundred
dollars more of the abovesamed property after my wife's death,
than my other children. All the rest of my estate both real
and personal, of what nature or quality soever it may be, not
herein before particularly disposed of, I desire may be sold
and equally divided amongst my several children Nathan, Charity,
Jefae, Ruth, Joseph, Henry, Thomas & Jackson, with the exception
of my little negro girl Carline whom I do not wish to be sold,
but that my daughter Ruth take her at appraisement as so much
her share of my estate. What ever I have given off to my
children, I do not wish to be returned into the Estate as any
part of the same, and I do hereby disown and disclaim

with do make & ordain this my last will, in manner following,
that is to say: I desire that all my just debts shall be paid
out of the monies owing to me: After payment of my just debts
and funeral expences, I give to my ^{wife} Sarah Whitmire all my lands
lying on the North side of Duncans Creek, my negro woman called
Rachel, and one of my horses whichever she may choose, one bed
& furniture and one year's provision, for and during the term
of her natural life; and after her decease, I give the same to
my children hereinafter mentioned, to be equally divided among
them, with the exception of my three youngest children viz,
Henry Thomas & Jackson whom I desire to ^{have} each one hundred
dollars more of the abovementioned property after my wife's death,
than my other children. All the rest of my estate both real
and personal, of what nature or quality soever it may be, not
herein before particularly disposed of, I desire may be sold
and equally divided amongst my several children Nathan, Charity,
Jefee, Ruth, Joseph, Henry, Thomas & Jackson, with the exception
of my little negro girl Carlina whom I do not wish to be sold,
but that my daughter Ruth take her at appraisement as so much
^{her} share of my estate. What ever I have given off to my
children, I do not wish to be returned into the estate in any
part of their share. And lastly, I do constitute and appoint
my sons Nathan and Jefee executors of this my last will and
testament: In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set
seal, this the twentyeth day of August one thousand eight
hundred and thirty one
