The Constitution of the Willow Swamp Church August 10th day 1805.
Met in conference at William Tyler on 7th day of August 1805. we were dismissed from Dean Swamp Church being in number thirty six and by the help of God and our Beloved Brethren James and Isaac Dubouque being the Presbytery sent to constitute us into a church we were legally then constituted and our Beloved Brethren Richard Simmons and Charles Folds were unanimously chosen Deacons to act in Deaconship and govern said church and were ordained by the Presbytery and Brother Adrial Elison chosen clerk of the church and then became a body of Members to act and transact our own business. which body of Members having given ourselves to the Lord and to ~~one another~~ in him a covenant to live together as becomes the church of Christ do think it necessary to enter into that Holy Rule of life our Lord and Saviour Jesus has left on record as

- 1st we believe the scriptures of the old and new testament to be the word of God in which word of truth revealed unto us God's power and Holiness as author of all good which first created man
- 2nd we believe in original depravity by man's transgressing the command of God.
- 3rd we believe in electing grace and effectual calling according to the determinate council and foreknowledge of God through Christ.
- 4th we believe in free justification through the merits of Christ and the Baptism of believers by immersion and on that ^{progressive} work of sanctification by the holy Spirit and fire.

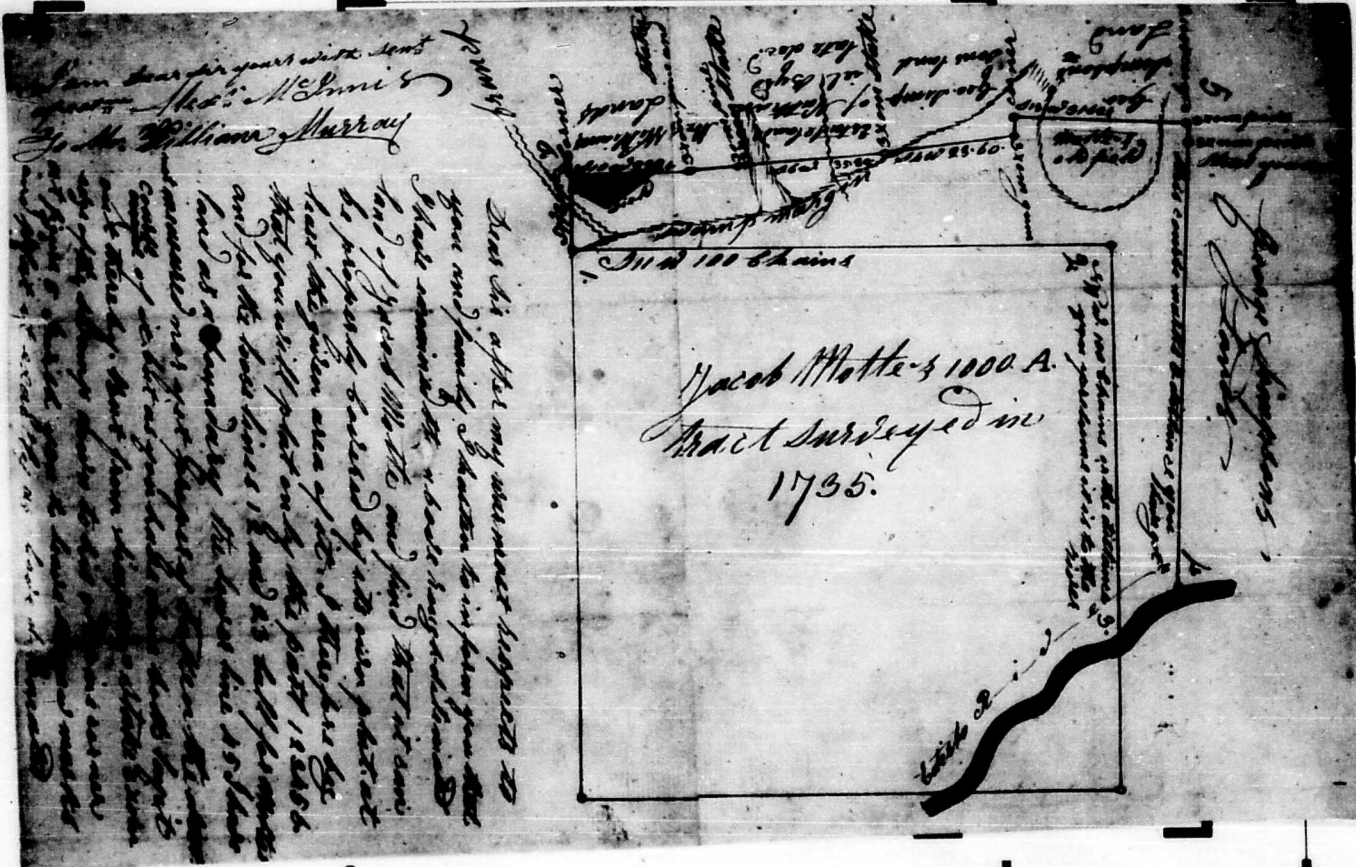
