 or if any Remain over & above to be Equally Divi-
 ded between her & all my Children when my youngest
 Son Charles Sinkler comes to the age of twenty one
 years or at the end of her widowhood and I leave
 my true & trusty wife ^{Sarah Sinkler} with my true & trusty friend
 William Murphy Executors & Managers of this my
 last will and Testament this 5th day of June 1793
