Cann to carry this will into Execution - hereby disannulling any other will or Wills by me written or made, and ratifying and declaring this and this alone my only true last Will and Testament. - In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this twenty eighth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety six and of the Independence of the United States of America the Twentieth.
