ordain this my last will and Testament That is to say, prin-
cipally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto
the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recom-
mend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial
at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but
at the General resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty power of God. and as touching such worldly
estate where with it hath pleased God to bless me in this
Life I give devise & Dispose of the same in the follow-
ing manner of form (first after all my lawful debts are
paid) I give and bequeath to all my Children that are
married (viz) Ann Gatchin James Moon David Alexander
Margaret Davis Catharine Browne Eliza Ann and James Alexander
Elizabeth Woods to each of them five Shillings I bequeath
to my son John Alexander a horse & saddle to cows & calves
some yearling Heifer that is claimed by him at present. I bequeath
to my son William Morrison Alexander a cow & some calf
claimed by him at present. I bequeath to my Daughter Ruth
Alexander one bed & furniture a three year old blue roan filly &
a bridle & saddle. I leave and bequeath to my Dear & beloved
wife Margaret Alexander (after the above Legacy is all paid of &
all my debts discharged) all my Estate both real & personal
my land stock & houses. cows hogs my bed & furniture together
with all my house hold furniture to her only use she be
disposed of as she pleases if she continues a widow, if she
marries it is my wife and desire that all the estate that she may
have in her possession that I now give her & may arise from

what I now give her be disposed of as follows she my loving
 wife to have my Roan mare & saddle & the rest to be equally
 divided between her and all my children above mentioned
 and if any thing should come to my Estate from my claims in
 a tract of land or ready given I give to each of my daughters
 above named a cow and calf & to my son James five pounds
 the remainder if any - to be equally divided among all
 my children - and I do by this present appoint my
 beloved wife Margaret Alexander & Stephen Willis my Ex-
 & Ec. to this my last will and Testament. and I do hereby
 utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every other for-
 mer Testaments, wills, &c. & Covenants by me in any wise before
 named, willing & agreeing ratifying, & confirming this and
 no other to be my last will & Testament In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fifth day
 of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
 and ninety five - signed sealed & delivered in the presence of
 us, who in the presence of each other
 have hereunto subscribed our names
