seven hundred and thirty five make and testify to
this my last will and testament in manner following
that is to say First I Give to my son Joseph James
all my wearing apparel which shall be at my De-
cease also Ten pounds of the money it being part of Money
Due to me in the State of Maryland if it is ever col-
lected. also I give and bequeath unto my Daughter
Hannah Ligon One Dollar to be paid within one full
Year after my Decease also I Give to my Daughter
Jenny Deane one Dollar to be paid to her at or within one
full Year after my decease, also I Give to my Daughter
Mary Carmichael One Dollar to be paid at the same time
also I give to my son John James One Dollar to be paid
at the said time, also I Give to my son Samuel James
one Dollar to be paid at the said time and also and every
other thing of my Estate real or Personal which shall
or may belong to me at my Death I Give and Bequeath
to my Dear wife Mary James forever I make and ordain
my son John James and Son Samuel James, Executors of this
my will, in trust for the intents and purposes in this my will con-
tained to do & perform the same according to my true intent
and meaning. In testimony whereof I the said Griffiths James
have to this my last will and testament set my hand & affixed
my seal the day & year above written; Signed & Delivered by
the said Griffiths James for his last will & testament
in the presence of us who were present at the signing and
