In the Name of God Amen, I John Smith of the County of Pendleton and State of S^c Carolina being weak in body, but of sound memory (blessed be God) do this 5th of December 1792 and of the sovereignty and independency of America the seventeenth make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following, (that is to say) first I give to my Mother Rachel Smith the plantation and tract of land whereon she now lives containing one hundred acres more or less to enjoy and possess the same during her natural life, and after her death I devise the same to William Smith, son of my sister Mary Smith and his heirs forever - Also I give and bequeath to my Mother afford one bay Mare and other property Notes and book accounts - Also I give to ^{her} William Smith son of Mary & one young bay mare or filly, and make and ordain her my Mother afford? sole executrix of this my will in trust for the intent and purposes, in this my will contained.

Signed sealed and delivered by the said John Smith as and for his last will and testament in the presence of us, who were present at the signing and sealing thereof
