and testament in the way and manner following viz
I first devote my soul to the Almighty God Who
gave it and next my body to be buried in a decent Chri-
stian burial according to the discretion of my
Executors And next I do leave and bequeath my dear
and loving wife Sophia her choice bed and bedding
of close and one branded Cow & a Dutch Oven & what
I had to my Eldest Son Robert. I do leave and
bequeath One half Dollar if Required, & to my son
Aquila One half Dollar & to my son Bennet, one half
Dollar. and to my Son Jonathan the Plantation
I now live upon. Together with my bay mare and colts
and to my son Michael I do leave him my gray
mare and to my daughter Fanny. I do leave her my
other bedding of Close and a Skirted, and to my son
Michael the large Pot. and to my son James Graham
One half Dollar. and I do leave my son Michael my
other Branded cow. and I do allow my son Jonathan
my gray horse and all my Plantation Utensils & his
to pay all my debts and Funeral Expenses And my Wife
to be willed and the price of her to be divided between
my wife and Youngest Daughter and I allow my hope
to the son of my Family alive & I do allow Maintain
& confirm this and no other to be my last will and
Testament & I also Allow anointment & authorize my
dear and loving wife Sophia and Jacob Visage to be
my whole and sole Executors. In Witness whereof
I do interchangeably set my hand and seal this 11th

day of February one thousand seven hundred and
ninety four. 1794
