

THE WILL OF MOSES LIDDELL

*Moses Liddell*

In the Name of God Amen ----

I Moses Liddell of the State of South Carolina Pendleton District (Yeoman) Being sick & weak of Body and of sound mind & Memory & understanding -- Praise be God for the same Do makes this my Last Will & Testament Viz. Principally & first of all I Give & recomen my soul unto the hands of Almighty God & Body to the Earth to Be buried in Decent Christian form at the Discretion of my Executors -- Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I Shall Receive the same again -- & as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to blefs me with in this life -- I Gave Demise & Dispose of in the following Manner Viz. I Do ordain & Constitute & appoint Elizabeth Liddell Executrix together with John Henderson and Adrew Liddle and Daniel Keith Executors -- first I Gave & bequeath to my Dearly Beloved Wife Elizabeth Liddell the full Benefict of the plantation I now Live on So Long as She Lived a widow -- then I Gave & Bequeath to my Two Sons Moses and James the plantatic before mentioned to be Divided Between them Equally tho they are not to have any Claim to the same on anywise So Long as my wife Elizabeth Liveth a widow the same being Left to the Discretion of my Executors also I Do Gave & allow my wife Elizabeth a Childs part of my real or personal Estate after my Debts & funeral Expense being paid -- also I allow my Executors to sell or Dispose of the following property for the purpose of paying all Demands against the aforesaid Estate Viz. a plantation or Tract of Land Where Thomas Blair now Liveth Also a plantation Where James Jones now Liveth Likewise the plantation Where William McLeskey now Liveth -- Likewise a Negro winch sarah & hir Child Charlott Likewise three Negro now in my posfession Viz. Negro fellow Named Jacob & his wife Sylva & a negro fellow named September -- And the Rest of my Real Estate or personal property I Gave and Bequeath to my Children to be Divided in the following Manner Viz. to be Divided Equally between My Daughter Elizabeth my son Moses & my son James & Bafther, Isabella & Jean my Daughters -- and I do Haraby Utterly Disallow Revoke and Disanul all & Every other former Testamints Wills Legacies Requests & Executors by me in any wise before Names -- Willed & bequeathed - Rectifying & Confirming this & no other to be my Last Will & Testament in Witnefs Whereof I have Set my hand & seal This first Day of May One Thousand Eight hundred & Two

Liveth with My wife Elizabeth Untill a mature age
