In the name of God Amen, I Daniel Dalrymple of Abbeville County, being very weak and low in body, but in perfect mind and memory, calling to mind, that it is appointed for Men once to die, I do make and declare this to be my last will and testament, and as God has been pleased to bless me with a portion of this worldly goods, I do divide in the manner and form following, that is to say, first I give my soul into the hands of God that gave it, and my body to be buried, in a Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors.

I do give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah, one third part of my movable estate, and one negro boy, to help to raise the children, and one third part of the plantation and tract of land where I now live, the negro and land to be my wife's during lifetime or widow's hood, and then to return to my son James. Secondly, I give to my daughter Rachel Laughlin, one hundred and twenty five acres of land, part of a tract lying on Rocky river, one feather bed and furniture, one hunting saddle and one cow and calf. I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sarah, Mary, and Elizabeth one tract of land, containing six hundred and seventy acres of land, lying on the head of coldwater a branch of Rocky river, and each of them one hunting saddle, and one cloak to Elizabeth

that if the land should be lost, then the value thereof shall be made up out of the rest of my movable estate. I give to my beloved son James, the plantation and tract of about one acre, containing three hundred and thirty acres, and one bay mare and sorrel colt ten years old. I give to my Nephew Samuel Dalrymple, the sorrel mare colt and half a year schooling and the colt be raised till two years old.

I give and bequeath, to my four youngest children to wit: Ann, Eliza, Deborah and Abigail, one plantation and tract of land containing two hundred acres, to be equally divided, the land lying on Stauch river.

And after all my debts being paid, then the rest of my estate to be divided between my wife and all my children if any remain. - And I do appoint my wife executrix and my Brother John Dalrymple executor of this my last will and testament, and I do hereby disavow all other wills and testaments, gifts and bequests whatsoever heretofore given or bequeathed, and do hereby acknowledge this to be my last will and testament, given from under my hand and seal this twenty first day of November 1791.
