Pickens County, South Carolina Will Book 1818 to 1863
and Southern Baptists

I, Alfred Hester, being weak in body but of a sound mind and understanding taking into consideration the frailties of human nature knowing that it is once appointed to all men to die I commit my body to the earth and my soul to God who gave it.

As to my earthly goods which God has been pleased to bestow on me I do make the following division after my burial expenses and all my just debts are paid.

ITEM the first. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah A. Burgess too hundred acres of land and house known by the Carwile house and negro woman Presillay and children James Shadrack Jane one negro they have now in possession to them and their heirs forever.

ITEM the second. I give and bequeath unto my son Baliss J. Hester, one-half of my upper plantation and what hogs I have there one sorrel horse saddle and bridle too cows and calves one plow and gears too hoes too sheep one negro woman namely Mariah and child Early and Andy to him and his heirs forever, and increase of the same, 2 beds furniture.

ITEM the third. I give and bequeath unto my son James B. Hester the other half of my upper plantation to bee equally divided between the two also one negro woman Chaney and child Emerson and increase one brown horse bridle and saddle too cows and calves too head of sheep too sows and pigs one plow and gears, and too hoes to him and his heirs forever also too beds and furniture.

ITEM the fourth. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Eady Hester the house where I know live and and all that tract of land I purchased of Mr. Packard except the 200 acres wild to Sarah Burgess being 520 acres, also one negro man Edmund and wife Hannah Reuben Rosa and Rachel and all my household and kitchen furniture after giving to Baliss and James too beds and furniture to each of them.

Also one sorrel mare too plows and one pair of gears, too hoes 4

head of choice sheep, 4 head of choice hogs one sow and pigs 2 cows and calves 40 barrels of corn and 2000 bnds of fodder to her during her natural life or widowhood and at her death I will to my son Baliss J. Hester one negro Reuben, to my son James Hannah and Rosa and their increase and all the balance of the property will go to my real and personal to be equally divided between my two sons Baliss and James and at my death my will is that Elizabeth and all my property not otherwise will away be sold by my executors and the money arising therefrom and money in hand or due me I will to my beloved wife for her support after paying all my just debts are paid and I do appoint my son Baliss J. Hester and David Blythe my Executors to execute this my last will and testament.

In witness I have hereunto set my hand and affixt my seal this 4th day of September 1844.
