IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN;

I, Allen Robinson, being weak in body but of a sound mind and understanding knowing that it is once appointed to man to die, I do commit my body to the earth and my soul to God to-ge who gave it and as to my earthly goods which God has been pleased to bless me with I do make the following division after my burial expenses and all my just debts are paid.

Item the first. As my son/^{James} has already been provided for and has no interest in this my will.

Item the 2. It is my wish that all my lands on the North side of the Creek down to the land thence up sd. lane to the cross fence thence along said fence to the creek to a conditional line thence along sd. line to Williams line, and my negro man James be sold on a credit of Twelve months and the money arising therefrom be equally divided between my too sons Joseph and Randle and my four daughters Ann Lyda Elizabeth and Martha after giving my too grandsons William Robinson one dollar and George Roberson one half a shear to them and their heirs forever.

Item 3. I give unto my beloved wife Catherine Roberson during her natural life the plantation whereon I now live that is all the cleared land and timber enough for the support of the plantation and at her decease to be equally divided between my too sons Jeremiah and Elisha to them and their heirs forever.

Item 4. I also give to my beloved wife Catharine and her too daughters Melinda and Lucy all my household and kitchen furniture and stock of every kind all money in hand and all money due me to be equally divided between them as my too daughters become of age or should marry each one to receive one-third part and at my wife decease all the property not otherwise disposed of in the will and all money in hand or due the estate to be equally divided/^{between} my four youngest children Jere-

nah, Elisha, Malinda and Lucy and for the purpose of carrying this
my will into effect I have appointed my son Jeremiah Robinson my Exe-
cutor to execute this my last will and testament revoking all former
wills made and this only to be put in execution.
