

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF BURT MOORE.

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:

I, Burt Moore of the State and District aforesaid being far advanced in years and calling to mind the certainty certainty of Death but being of sound mind and memory although my body is feeble do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following -

I will my soul to my God and my body to the dust from whence it and as to all my worldly goods and chattels both real and personal I will and bequeath as follows -

I will to my wife Mary her bed and furniture and bed sted one large pine chest with all her wearing apparel and some earthen ware my dwelling house and kitching with a freehold of Twenty acres of land around the same to be by her laid off during her natural life and at her death said freehold goes to the balance of my tract and to my youngest son Hughey who is to have the same.

I will to my youngest son Hughey all my freehold on which I live except the twenty acres set apart for his mother one cow and calf and one negro man named Frank, including all the lands adjoining each other where I now live.

I will that all the balance and remainder of my estate both real and personal of all kinds be sold to the highest bidder under the direction of my Executor and all my just debts with my funeral expenses be first paid. The balance and remainder whatever may be I will and direct that it be equally divided among my legal heirs and representatives counting off from each one of them a certain sum of money which I this day set down and charge to them being being so much over the proportion given to the rest, all except my wife Mary and my son Hughey is included in the last division my land where David Moore now lives is included in the last division and is to be sold and for the purpose of carrying this my last will and testament in full force and effect I do constitute ordain and appoint my true

and trusty friend Bailey Barton my Executor to act for me and revoke
and make null all contracts wills or decrees heretofore made by me.

year.
