Also I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lurana Duranda my sorrel filly and lastly as to all the rest residue and remainder of my rale and personal estate goods and chattels of what ever kind and nature ecever I give and bequeath the same to my beloved wife during her natural life or her widowhood and then to be sold and equally divided between my children, and lastly my beloved wife Rosannah whome I hereby appointe sole Executrix of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me maid.
