IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:

I, Felix Rogers, of the District of Abbeville and State afore-
said, being infirm in body, but of sound and disposing mind, memory
and understanding praise be God for the same, I do make and declare
this my last will and testament in the manner and form following, viz

It is my will and desire after my decease my Executors herein
after named do pay all my just debts and funeral expences.

~~I do~~ I do further will that all of my estate both real and personal
be left and remain in the hands of my beloved wife Casandra Rodgers
and my son Daniel Rodgers, which I do appoint my lawful Executors,
for the special purpose and benefit of raising all my children until
the youngest children comes of age or at the death of my beloved
wife above named, then I ~~will~~ will if any of my estate then re-
maining shall be sold by my Executors, and my beloved wife to have
one-third of my estate both real and personal and the ballance to be
equally divide amongst my children hereafter named, viz, Elizabeth,
Daniel, Lieuercole Harris, Marquis Butte, ^{PARKINS} Milton Jenkins, ~~and~~
Amanda, Francis Marion and Benjamin Franklin Rodgers, or all my law-
ful children if any not name.
