IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN;

I, Gideon Roper, being of sound mind and weake in boddy and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death have concluded to make this my last will and testament.

First, I will my soul to God who gave it.

Second, I will that all my just ~~asset~~ and funeral expenses be paid.

3rd. I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Roper my whole ~~estate~~ both real and personal to manage as she sees proper during her natural life time and at her death to be equally divided among my lawful heirs.

4th. I will that when aney of my children comes of age or marries as fare as my wife can spare sow as to be equal among them all she may call in three disinterested/^{men} and have aney thing she may have to spare appraised and keep a true record of the same sow as to be equal this the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundre sixty-one September 3rd day.
