one pillow and one quilt cover & one stand of curtains and ten dollars
in money.

4th. I wish all the remaining part of my effects not above men-
tioned and after paying all my just debts and funeral expences and the
ten dollars to Mary Collins to be equally divided between my wife Mary
Hall and my two daughters Salena Spensor and Sarah Thompson.

5th. And lastly I constitute and appoint my much esteemed friend
R. A. Gilme Executor of this my last will and testament.
