IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:

I, Catharine Humphres being of sound mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of this life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with do make and ordain this my last will in manner and form following, that is to say I desire that there be immediately sold after my decease as much of my property as will discharge my just debts and funeral expense.

I will and bequeath unto my son William Humphres two dollars and I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Jones the wife of Richard Jones one negro boy by the name of Joseph Berry Benson between one and two years old and now in my possession. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebeckey Thomas the wife of Wiley Thomas, deceased, one negro woman by the name of Nise now in my possession, also my bed and furniture and I give and bequeath unto my son Isaac Humphres thirty dollars and I give and bequeath unto my son John Humphres all the land left me by his father and I give and bequeath unto my daughter Catharine Payne one negro girl by the name of Chane now in my possession. I also give to my children that is to say to my daughters Elizabeth Jones Rebeckey Thomas Isaac Humphres John Humphres Catharine Payne the ballence of my property to be equally divided between them and I appoint Rebeckey Thomas and Robert H. Briggs my Executrix and Executor of this my last will and testament revoking all other wills <sup>made</sup> by me in witness whereof I have hereunto my hand and seal this sixth day of October and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two signed published and delivered by the above named Catharine Humphres to be her last will and testament in the presents of us who have hereunto subscribed in the presents of the testator.
