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being very sick and in perfect mind and memory thanks be given to
God calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is
once appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my last will
and testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and
recommend my soul into the hand of almighty God that give ^{it} and my body
I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at
the discretion of my Exe'tors nothing doubting but at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same agains by the mighty power of
God and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleas'd
God to bless me in this life I give dismiss and dispose of the same
in following manner or form -

First I give to my well beloved wife Mary Land the all of my
living property and household property enduring her widowhood and
if she should marry it is to be equally divided between her and my
two children Nancy Willbern Land and Wm. Land. Also she is to live
on my land indureing her widowhood or life and then said land is to
be divided equally between the two children - Nancy Willbern Land
and Wm. Land, Juneyear. Also I give to well beloved son and daughter
all my lands that I own in the said District of picking aforesaid
whom I likewise constitute and make the sole Executors this my last
will and testament all and singular my lands messages and testament
by them - feely to be possessed enjoied and I do hereby utterly dis-
allow revoke and disannul all every other former testament wills
legacies bequests and executors by me in anywise before mentioned
or named willed/bequeathed ratified and confirming this and no other
to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 29th day of October one thousand eight
hundred and twenty nine.

and delivered by the said Isaac Land
as his last will and testament, in
