I will to my beloved wife Anna Guyton all my land to-wit 165 acres with everything belonging to the premises after my just debts are paid, so long as she lives or remains a widow. But if she should marry I only will to her one bed and furniture and her wearing apparel.

I will that my daughter Polly be equal sharer and partaker of all profits and benefits arising from said premises goods and chattels. And if my daughter Polly should marry while her and her mother live together, that her mother apportion to her at her will and pleasure; And at the close of either of their lives the survivor to take and possess all.
