PICKENS DISTRICT.

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:

I, Jesse Sugg, Sen'r, of State and Disct aforesaid Being of sound and disposing mind and memory but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it hath please God to bless me with do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say

I desire that after my death all my just debts should be paid after that I give to my wife Elizabeth Sugg during her lifetime or widowhood all of my property consisting of the land I now live on my stock of horses cattle sheep & hogs and all my household & kitchen furniture and in fact everything I possess except that I desire that each of my children by my first wife should have fifty cents each names as follows Rebecca Arpe or Orphea Allen John Sarah Winney Loven Jesse and Elizabeth and after the death or marriage of my wife Elizabeth Sugg I desire that my property before described should be equally divide between my two sons Elias and Elijah provided or on condition they pay to my two daughter Charlotte and Dorcas one hundred dollars each in cash or property at cash rate to be valued by my Executors.

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my friends James M. Barton and James Ferguson, Jun'r, Executors to my last will and testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventh August 1838.
