KNOW know ye all whom it may concern that I, Garland F. Jones, now being of sound mind and in good health, and knowing that it is appointed for man to die, do hereby and now do make this my last will and testament revoking all others if any heretofore made, and now distribute my worldly effects to my beloved wife and children as follows, to-wit:

ITEM 1st. I give to my beloved wife Gracia Carolina, during her widowhood all my real and personal estate of every description, she first paying all my just debts and funeral expenses, and if she my said wife shall marry again before her death then it is my will and I order that my Executors proceed to advertise and sell at publick sale all of my said estate as before mentioned, and to give my said wife one-third of the next proceeds of the said estate, and the remaining two-thirds to be equally divided between my three children, to-wit, James, Henry, Emery Lawrence and Zeley Ann. I also desire and request that as my children comes of age to give each of them some household furniture if she may have it to spare at that time.

ITEM. I hereby appoint my beloved wife Gracia Carolina and Joel Jones and Alva Griffin my lawful Executors to transact and carry out this my last will and testament, and I hereby request that my Executors shall when they think it necessary, after my death to cause all my estate or effects to be appraised by three good and sufficient persons and to make out a true inventory of the same so as my children when of age may no what it is.
