I, John Lidai of the District of Pickens and State of South Carolina, being of sound and disposing mind and memory but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with Do make and ordain this my last will in manner following, that is to say -

I desire that my negro boy Solomon be immediately sold after my decease and out of the money arising therefrom all my just debts be paid and the balance of s'd money to be equally divided amongst my children Mary Abraham Adam and Henry Lidai's Also Anna Owens - and Katharine Wallis I give her part to her two children Jeremiah & Anna Wallis. I give to my sons Abraham Adam & Henry Lidai all my land to be equally divide amongst them to them and their heirs forever. I likewise give unto my wife Eleanor all the household and kitchen furniture she brought with her when I married her to her and her heirs forever. I likewise give unto my daughter Mary one Bay horse colt two years old and one cow. Also I give to my son Henry one small Bay horse colt with a blaze face also my rifle gun and one cow to him and his heirs forever. I likewise give unto my wife Eleanor one brindled heifer three years old to her and her heirs. The balance of my property I leave to be equally divided amongst my children Mary Abraham Adam & Henry Lidai also Anna Owens, and Katharine Wallis's part I give to her two children Jeremiah and Anna Wallis to them their Exe heir Executors and Administrators and Assigns forever.

And lastly I do appoint and constitute William Whitmire & my son Abraham Lidai Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other and former wills & testaments by me heretofore made in tistemony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Fifth day of May in the year of our Lord 1842.
