I, Rebecca Niebuhr, of the Town of Walhalla, in the District of Pickens and State of South Carolina, being of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life, do therefore make, ordain, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, that is to say,

First, after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged, the residue of my estate, real and personal, I give and bequeath to my three children Henry, Peter and Carolina, to be divided among them share and share alike.

And I hereby give to the Executors of this my last will and to the Guardians of my children full power to sell any property real and personal and to reinvest of the proceeds or part of it to the best of their judgment.

Likewise I make, constitute and appoint Herman Knill and H. W. Kuhlman to be Executors of this my last will and testament, and to be Guardians to my three children, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
