ITEM 3rd. It is my will and desire that my wife remain in full possession of all of my property both real and personal after all of my debts is paid for her to retain in her possession for the benefit and support of her and my children. I give to my wife the power to sell or dispose of any or all of my property if she should think it would be to her interest and the interest of my children.

ITEM 4th. I now appoint my wife Rebecca and my brother John Hardin my Executors to this my last Will and Testament.

GIVEN under my hand and seal this the 25th twenty-fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven.
