ITEM 4th. It is my will and desire that after the death of my wife all the property that she may be possessed of together with the increase be equally divided between my two daughters Charlotte & Rebecca & son Moses Samuel Messer.

ITEM 5th. I have given to my son John H. Messer previous to this will a full and equal share with the balance of my children. I now give him five dollars if demanded.

ITEM 6. I constitute and appoint Clarisa my wife my only and lawful Executor. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 9th day of Decbr in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three.
