me with do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner
following, towit -

1. I will and devise that all my just debts and funeral expences be paid.

2nd. I devise give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Louisa H. Robinson all of my estate both real and personal to have and to hold the same for her use and benefit during her natural life or widowhood and at her death or marriage I desire all my property to be sold by my Executors and distributed according to the hereinafter named devise.

3rd. I devise and give my wife Louisa M. Robinson should she live and remain a widow until any of my children becomes of age or marries and leaves her, power to help the child or children so far as she can be without doing an injury to the rest of my children however in all cases taking their receipts for the amounts received to be record against them in final distribution except my son James M. Robinson who I wish to have nothing of my estate untill final distribution of the same.

4th. I devise give and bequeath to Meredith H. Brock in trust for my son James M. Robinson an equal share of my estate at the final distribution to be by him the said M. H. Brock held in trust solely for the use and special benefit of my said son James M. Robinson and his children and should he the ^{said} James M. Robinson die without children then the share given in trust for his special benefit to return back to my estate and be equally divided between the rest of my children.

5th. I devise and will that should my wife Marry that the whole of my property real and personal be sold by my Executor and the proceeds equally divided between my wife Louisa M. Robinson and my chil-

are that survive at that time all share and share alike.

6th. And lastly I constitute and appoint my Brother-in-law Heredith H. Brock Executor to execute this my last will and testament heretofore by me made, revoking all former wills and testaments by me made and confirming this my last will, and testament.
