IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:

I, Benjamin Smith of the State and District aforesaid being in a low state of health but of sound mind and memory thanks be to God for his goodness to me Doe make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following, that is to say -

First, I recommend my Soul to God who gave it and my body to the ground to be Decently Buried at the discretion of my Executors and as for what worldly property it hath pleased God to bless me with I dispose of in manner following, that is to say -

ITEM 1st. I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Rebecah Chapman an equal or a proportionable part of my property or an equal part of money after my property may be sold and Expences paid by my Executors.

ITEM 2nd. I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Agnew an equal part of property or money as may be thought best by my Executors.

ITEM 3rd. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Hanah Addams an equal or proportionable part with the above named legattes and one loom and one paire of Stillards and one looking glass.

ITEM 4th. I Give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth McKinney an equal part of my property or money.

ITEM 5th. I give & Bequeath my son James Smith an equal or proportionable part of my property or money with my Daughters except Hanah Addams.

ITEM 6th. I give and bequeath to my son Job Smith an equal and proportionable part with my son James either in property or money.

ITEM 7th. I give and Bequeath to my son Jonathan Smith an equal part withe rest of his Brothers of my property or money.

ITEM 8th. I give and Bequeath to my son Wm. Smith an equal or proportionable part of my property or money.

ITEM 9th. I give and Bequeath to my son David Smith an equal or proportionable part of my property or in money.

ITEM 10th. I give and bequeath to my son Sidney Smith an equal or proportionable part of my property or in money after my Executors

Lastly I Doe Constitute and appoint my son James Smith William
Smith & Elijah Addams Executors of this my last Will and Testament
revoking all other Wills & Testaments by me made and only confirming
