

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:

Know ye that I, Tempy Mayfield, wife of but now the widow of William Mayfield, Deceat, late of the State of Georgia and County of Hall, knowing that I am old and feeble for all mankind to die, and I, tho now in strong mind do hereby make this my last will and testament, revoking all others if any and do hereby bequeath all my estate as follows, to-wit:

ITEM. I first, I do hereby appoint Bennett C. Jones and Larkin Hendricks my lawful Executors to carry out and into effect this my said last will and testament.

ITEM. I desire that at and after my death my body be decently buried and in decent order by my Executors with the assistance of my son-in-law Samuel Chapman, and,

ITEM. I do first give my side saddle, one feather bed all my bed furniture to my granddaughter Octava Chapman.

ITEM. I give unto my daughter Elisabeth (who is the wife of Samuel Chapman) all my real and personal estate after paying all my just debts if there should be any; which estate is coming from the estate of my late husband, William Mayfield, Deceat, to me, and I do hereby request and invoke the Administrator of the said William Mayfield, late of aforesaid Hall County, that so soon after my death that he when called on so to do to pay over to the said bequest as above to my daughter Elisabeth and her husband Samuel Chapman the same; or whatsoever may have or may be coming to me of said estate as tho I was yet alive and present whatsoever after the division of the said estate of William Mayfield, Deceat, my late husband would of come to me, after the sails are over.

In witness of and in testimony of the same I hereunto subscribe my name and affix my seal this 26th day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine (1859).
