IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN;

I, Thomas Milton Reeder being weak in body but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will and testament.

ITEM 1st. It is my desire that after I am dead my body be decently buried.

ITEM 2d. It is my desire my Horse shall be sold to pay all my just debts.

ITEM 3- It is my desire that my Brother Benjamin F. Reeder and Amanda F. Reeder and Elizabeth Reeder shall have my negro boy Tayler to be equally divided among them.

ITEM 4. It is my desire that Amanda F. Reeder have the overplus coming to me in settlem't which I believe is seventy some odd dollars.

ITEM 5th. It is my will & desire that after the death of my Mother that my undivided interest be divided among the following persons equally Lewis W. Reeder my Brother Samuel C. Reeder My Sister Matilda Harben my Brother Andrew P. Reeder my Brother James Ma Reeder and my half sister Sarah Ward a half a child's part.

ITEM 6th. I constitute & appoint Samuel C. Reeder my only and lawful Executor to transact all my business as he seemeth best.

ITEM 7th. I give my Sister Mary Cleveland one dollar if demanded.

ITEM 8. I give my half Brother Joel Reeder one dollar if demanded.
