I desire also that after my wife's death that my youngest son Thomas Oliver Trammel shall heir all the above mentioned property, viz, the land houses stock farming tools and &c. In consideration of the above named fifty acres of land/<sup>which I will</sup> to my son B. W. Trammel he is bound to assist his mother in her business be dutiful helpful to her in her efforts to make a comfortable support for her family and pay all just debts against my estate.

I do hereby constitute my wife Racheal Trammel Executrix to this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former will and testaments by me heretofore made.
