the said land to be equally divided between the heirs of my said
daughter Mary Laurence. I also give to my daughter Milly Visage all
my household and kitchen furniture and all my farming utensils. I
also give to my said daughter Milly my sorrel filly. I also give to
my daughter Catharine Leathers and her heirs all of my part of that
tract of land jointly surveyed by myself and my son James Visage and
to be equally divided between us let the Grant come in whose name it
may.

Lastly and finally I appoint my much esteemed friend E. Hughes
Executor of this my last will and testament.
