

I Adam Edgar of the Town of Columbia being of sound memory
and understanding thanks be to God for the same do make and
ordain this to be my last will and Testament in manner & form
following.-----

Item - I give devise and bequeath unto my well beloved
wife Frances Edgar three Lots of Land containing half an acre
each situate in the Town of Columbia including all the Build-
ings thereon known in the Plan of said Town by the numbers
Seventy one and Seventy two on Lady Street and Number twenty
five on Gervais Street. Also three other Lots in said Town
known in the plan thereof by the Numbers Seventy four Seventy
five and Seventy Six on Lady Street. Also my Lot in said
Town bounded East and North by William Mayhans Lot and west
by James S. Rawls Also one square of Land in Columbia bounded
North by Richland Street South by Laurel Street East by Wayne
Street and west by Polaski Street. Also my Lot in Camden now
occupied by the Telegraph office together with all the Buildings
thereon which are at present under the care of Adam Edgar Allen
Also the whole of my Household and Kitchen furniture Plantation
and farming Tools of every discription.-----

Also my carriage Horses & Harness --- Waggon & H Geer Stock of
Cattle etc. also twenty two Slaves Viz Rosetta Thomas, Amey
Frances Charlotte and Eliza Charity Mary Maria Charlotte Phillis
Susan - Rolla Ephrain and wife Sarah, Henry Maria Thomas . Allen
Richard Clarissa & Phebe with their future increase Also four
hundred shares in the Hamburg Bank, two hundred and five
shares in the Bank of Camden, twenty shares in the Commercial
Bank of Columbia as per Stock Certificate No 672 which she
has already in her possession and fifty five shares in the
Greenville & Columbia Rail Road Company, -- Also a Note of William
Lewis for one thousand Dollars to her and her heirs and assigns
forever. -- and which bequests are to be considered in leiu or
bar of any claim of Dower which she may be entitled to upon my
Estate. And it is my express will and intention that she receive

to deliver over to her immediately after my decease and which
is to be under her own management and control.

Item 2- I give and bequeath unto Adam Edgar Hardy and Elizabeth
Edgar Hardy the children of my Nephew Adam Hardy Son of Robert
and Hannah Hardy of four point Edinburg in Scotland five hundred
and three shares in the Commercial Bank of Columbia when they
become of age to be equally divided between them and should
either of them die leaving no lawful issue then the ~~same~~ same
to belong to the Survivors his her or their heirs and assigns
for ever,

Item -3 I give devise and bequeath unto William Shiell and
John Shiell Sons of my N~~e~~ Neice Betsey Sheill my Lots of Land
containing one acre more or less situate in Columbia fronting
one hundred and four feet more or less on # Richardson Street
of the same on Sumter Street & fronting four hundred and Seven-
teen feet five Inches on Lady Street bounded west by Richardson
Street South by Lady Street East by Sumter Street and North by
James Boatwright Lots. Also one Slave named Horace . Also one
hundred and five and a half shares of Columbia Bridge Stock. Also
twenty Shares in the Charlotte and South Carolina Rail Road
Company. Also forty ~~shares~~ in the Columbia Insurance Company
Also William Mabins Bond to me a Balance due thereon of about
Seventeen thousand Dollars. Also a Bond of Judge Roads of three
thousand Dollars Also a Note of Thomas Hendereons as well as
any other and all debts which may be due me at the time of my
death not herein before mentioned say after first paying all
debts which I may owe subject nevertheless to the payment of th
the following annuities say five hundred Dollars per annum
to be paid by them to their Mother Betsey Sheill each and every
year during the Term of her natural life and also that their
said Mother be furnished with a comfortable House to live in
should she remove from her present abode, it is my wish that she
should occupy the House and out Buildings at the Corner of Lady
& Sumter Street now occupied by Mrs Macfitter and the said

William and John Shields are to pay over to their Aunt Jane Sheill the dividends of ten shares in the Columbia Bridge Company for and during the term of her natural life. Also fifteen shares of Commercial Bank Stock, to them and their Heirs and assigns forever. But should the said William Shiell and John Sheill die leaving no child or children then and in such case I give devise and bequeath the Houses and Lots described in this Item unto Adam Edgar Hardy and Margaret Edgar Hardy to them or the Survivors of them his her or their heirs and assigns for ever.

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my friends William Sheill and John Sheill Executors to this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all others by me heretofore made.

It is further my will and desire that all Monies on hand at my decease one half thereof to belong to my said wife and the remaining half to be equally divided between William and John Sheill.
