

In the name of God amen I Adam Frederick Hamiter of Cedar Creek, in the district of Richland being Sick and weak in body, but of Sound and disposing mind memory and understanding praised be god for the Same, do make and declare this my Last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to Say 1- I give and bequeath unto my wife barbara Hamiter, my dwelling house wherein I now dwell and one Hundred acres of Land of my old Tract at her pleasure to make choice to take it where she please and one third part of all my moveable property consisting of Negroes Stock and plantation House and Kitchen etc. and crop of Every Kind and money etc. etc. during during her natural Life or widowhood, and after her decease to be Equally divided between my children namely Frederick, John George, David, John and nancy and polly Except the House and Land to belong to my Son

John forever . Secondly- I give and bequeath to my beloved Son fredrick all my Land Lying on cedar Creek in three different Trackts one of one hundred acres and one of ninety Eight and one of twenty Seven in all two hundred and twenty nine acres more or Less as the plats may hold out etc. for ever but my Son Frederick is to pay to my Son John George, two hundred dollars in the Space of two years after my death in Liew of any part of my Land thirdly- I give and bequeath to my beloved Son ~~David~~, a certain peace of Land out of my old Tract of Land to be Known by a brach called the School house branch, all above Said branch to the upper Line of my Said old Tract and to the creek called Little cedar creek on the South Side of the Same being about twenty five acres more or less also two hundred and Eighty Eight acres where he now Lives to be taken out of Medills Tract So call. for ever---- FourthlyI give and bequeath unto my Loving Son John the balance of my Tract of Land Say my old Tract Suppesed to be two hundred and twenty five acres more or Less also the bellance of my Tract call. medills Tract Supposed

5. Itom I give and bequeath to my two daughters nancy Turnipsed and poly Turnipseed five hundred dollars Each in Liew of Land more and above an Equil portion of my personal Estate-----

6. Itom give five dollars to daniel Gradiok--

7. Itom it is my will that after my decease that my house and Land which I bequeathed to my wife during her natural Life do belonG to my beloved Son John for Ever--

8. Itom my will is that all my moveable property be Sold at vendue on a creditot of Six months and after that divide the money in this manner one third part to go to my beloved wife and the other two thirds to be Equilly divided between my Sons and daughters, Frederick, John Georg, David, John , nancy, and pollyand I do nominate Constitue and appoint my Son Frederick NHamiter and my Son David Hamiter Executors, of this my Last will and Testament hereby Revoking and makingvoid all and Every other will and wills at any time here-tofore by me made and do declare this to be my Last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 8th day of Juge in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty two.
