and Likewise I give the other half that I now Live on to Abraham Adams together with fourteen acres in the River Swamp and all the Remaining Part of my Estate I give unto my beloved Wife During her widowhood and if she should marry Abraham Adams is to have one half of it and at her Death it is all to be Left to Abraham.
