I give and bequeath Unto my loving Wife Hannah Delozeair Seven Negroes to (wit) Rachell and her three children by name Mary Elizer & Joe and my two Negro men by name Ben & Charles and a house and lot in Charleston with all my Real and Persohal Estate with my Household and Chichen Furneture and Stock of Horses Cattle and hoggs and every other Species of property be it of whatsoever Nature it will to have ~~and~~ to hold the same unto my wife Hannah Delozeair to her and her Heirs forever And I do hereby nominate and My Dear Wife Hannah Delozeair to be Executrix with my Brother Edward Delozeair and my Trusty friend John Bostick Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby Revoke all other & former Wills by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Eleventh day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Nine and in the 34th year of american Independence
