I make no provisions for any child that may be livin to me
after my death as I am perfectly satisfied that my said wife
would do for such child that a mother should do and I prefer
that she should have the absolute disposition of whatever I
posse s I hereby revoke all other wills or testaments hereto
fore made by me.-----

I nominate Percival Borcher Executor and my said wife Eliza
Marion Executrix of this my will.-----

Nov 1851.-----
