Wright Harris all my Lands lying in Richland District on
Colonels Creek Waters of the Wateree River also my two Negros
Corah, and Penny together with their increase, to Her and her
heirs forever It is my Will that my Lands at the Death of my
Wife Mary W. Harris shall Descent to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth
McVoy to her and to the Heirs of Body forever --- Also I give
and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary W. Harris all the rest
of my Personal property of every description consisting of
~~Household and Kitchen furniture, Horses, Cattle, and Stock of~~
every description- my Waggon and Plantation Tools of every
description- The whole to be at her disposal as She may think
proper- Also I do ordain and appoint my beloved Wife Mary W.
Harris Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament In
Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this
thirteenth Day May in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight
hundred and Twenty three, and of the Independence of the
United States of America the Forty seventh--
