First I Commend my Soul to the Almighty God hoping his most merciful Acceptance of it. I do also recommend my Body to the Earth from whence it came, to be buried Decently at the Discretion of my Executors and friends hereafter mentioned, I Request all my just debts shall be paid to all who I may be lawfully Indebted - and for what worldly Goods it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give and Bequeath unto my much beloved and Dutiful Nephews & Neices the sons and Daughters of my affectionate Sisters which are, Martha & Hannah McCord, to them and their heirs forever I Give my Real and personal Estate to be Divided Equally among the said heirs without Distinction, I do will and bequeath my land as follows

First it is my will and desire that my Beloved Sister Martha McCord should have one half of my land During her life time and then return to her heirs & theirs forever I Also Give and Bequeath the other half to the Heirs of my beloved Sister Hannah McCord to them and their Heirs forever

I do also will and Bequeath to Each of my Beloved Sisters the sum of three pounds Sterling I do also Apoint my affectionat Sisters Martha & Hannah McCord to be Executors to my last will and Testament. I Do hereby appoint & nominate them to be my lawfull Executors I do also Certify this to be my last will and Testament in presence of the Testators this 20th of September 1805
