STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINE

In the Name of God Amen, I, Jane Curry being very Sick and weak but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God calling unto mind the Mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed of all once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I give & Recommend my Soul unto the hands of almighty God that gave it, and my body I Recommend to the earth to buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I Shall receive the Same again by the Mighty Power of God and as touching Such worldly Estate where with it has pleased God to bless me with in this Life I give and devise and Dispose of the Same in manner and Forme following First, I give and bequeath to my Son Stephen Curry, Tim and his wench Lucy, forever. Secondly I gave & bequeath to my Granddaughters and Jane Curry two Negro girls Named Liddy and to them and thier heirs forever Thirdly I give and bequeath to My Daughter Hannah Westcott two Negroes Named Dolly and Peter as long as she lives and then to fall to my GrandSon Samuel Westcott and if Samuel Westcott Should Die without an heir the Said Negroes and thier Isshew shall fall to my Son Stephen Curry and his heirs forever Also I Constitute Stephen and Benj Grubb to be Executors of this my last will & Testament & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other form Testament Wills legacies bequeaths & Executors by me in any wise before Named Willed & bequeathed Ratifying & Confirming this & no others to be my last will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 25th day of October 1787
