of David Coalter dec'd bearing date the 1st day of November 1817 of which the following is a Copy, To Wit -----

In the name of God, Amen, I David Coalter do make this my last will and Testament. 1. I wish my lands in South Carolina to be sold in the best practicable terms for the payment of all my debts, the proceeds to be applied in the first instance to that purpose, and the balance (if any) to be laid out by my executors in Land in the Missouri Territory if my Wife should choose to remove to that Country. 2. If the fund arising from the sale of the said Land be insufficient for the payments of my debts I wish my executors to sell any other property of mine in their discretion to supply the deficiency. 3. the residue of my Estate real and personal I devise as follows, One Third to my Wife for life and after her death to go into the bulk of the Estate, to be distributed in like manner with it as follows. 4. The residue of my Estate including the part of my wife after her death, I wish to be equally divided among my Seven Children, but if either of my Sons die under twenty one years of age and without children, or if either of my Daughters die without children, then I wish the part of such son or Daughter to be equally divided among the survivors of my said Children under the same limitations. 5. I wish my sons to be educated as gentlemen and scholars and to be instructed in some profession fully, and that if the income of either should be insufficient to defray the expenses of such education and a Corresponding maintenance, Then any further expence necessary for that purpose shall be defrayed out of the bulk of my Estate. 6. I appoint my wife Ann Coalter Executrix and my friends William Harper, David Harper Means, David Rumph, and Nathaniel Beverly Tucker Executors of this my last will and Testament, With
