The Last and Testament of John Dadd Dec'd

South Carolina

Richland County In the year of our Lord 1795 Feb'y 15th

Know all Men by These Presents that I John Dadd being in sound mind do make this my last Will and Testament It is my will that all my just debts be paid I appoint Ulrick Beard and Captain Daniel Stoddell Sen'r my Executors to sue for and recover all my debts dues and demands and after the payment of my just debts the Remainder and Residue of Estate shall be sold excepting such articles as my beloved wife Nancy shall think proper to keep It extends no farther in this Expression than my beloved wife Nancy shall only have the Household Furniture at her command the rest part of my Estate is intrusted to my Executors. The Remainder of my Property is to be sold and equally divided and my wife to have her proportionable part with her children the property which shall be the dividend of each of my children by Name Thomas, Elizabeth, John and William, shall be lodged in the hands of my Executors Ulrick Beard and Daniel Stoddell Sen'r. of Charleston to appropriate that money to the education of my beloved children according to the best of their abilities in bringing them in the Paths of Virtue and giving them such Professions as will get them a livelihood honestly, Trusting in God for the Salvation of my soul and in the Integrity of my Executors Thereby sign my hand and Name in the presence of three Witnesses
