IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN I Mathew Duncan being sick in body but
of sound senses and memory thanks be given unto God for the
same, but calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing
it is appointed unto all men once to die, do make and Ordain this
my last will and Testament, in manner and form following. That
is to say first and Above all I recommend my soul into the hands
of Almighty God who gave it, and my body ^I ~~bequeath~~ to the Earth
to be Decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter
Named, Nothing Doubting but at the general resurrection it will

such wordly Estate wherewith it hath pleased god to give me in
this life, I give and Dispose of the Same in the following manner
and form Item, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Brothers
Thomas Duncan two hundred and fifty acres of Land laying in
Berty County in Virginia, for the titles of which land, I have
in the hand of my brotherinlaw (W^m Wilson) a bond due from my
father mother Duncan, which land I give to him, (S^d Tho.) and to
his heirs assigns forever Item, My Land in Kentucky laying in
the lhands of my Brother, James, I give and bequeath unto my
beloved Brother Joseph Duncan, Sr to his heirs I assigns forever
Item, I give and bequeath unto my beloved Brother Seth Duncan
and to his heirs and assigns forever my young Sorrell Stud Horse
Item the notes of hand which lay is the hand of Mossee Hunter
given me by John Milling it is my Desire it should be given up
to Milling - Item The notes laying in the hands of my Brother
Tho. Duncan given me by John Copland, it is my desire should
be given up to Copland- Item the other notes due me which are
at home and with me, I wish to pay all my just debts and funeral
charges, and the ballance thereon to be equally Divided between
my beloved Sister Sarah Greear and Seth Duncan to them and their
heirs forever And Lastly, I do hereby nominate constitute and
appoint my Beloved Brother Thomas Duncan and Thomas Hutchinson
