return to James Montgomery during his life then to Mar-
garet Mongomery

Secondly I also give and bequeath unto Margaret Mongomery
Martha Mongomery & Elizabeth Spigner - all my clothing to
be equally devided among the three Margaret & Martha Mon-
gomery & Elizabeth Spigner

Thirdly I do give and bequeath to my friends John Mongom-
ery & Samuel Spigner all the money which is now owing to
me by Hix Chappell lawyer & John Chappell of Richland Dis-
trict and Laban Chappell of Fairfield District to be equal-
ly devided between John Mongomery & Samuel Spigner to be
raised and levied out of my estate which is due me - I
likewise constitate make and ordain this my last will and
testament

I also bequeath unto John Mongomery and Samuel Spigner my
part of the land which is in the percession of Col. David
