Secondly I also give and bequeath unto Margaret Montgomery Martha Montgomery & Elizabeth Spigner - all my clothing to be equally devided among the three Margaret & Martha Montgomery & Elizabeth Spigner

Thirdly I do give and bequeath to my friends John Mongomery & Samuel Spigner all the money which is now owing to me by Hix Chappell lawyer & John Chappell of Richland District and Laban Chappell of Fairfield District to be equally devided between John Montgomery & Samuel Spigner to be raised and levied out of my estate which is due me - I likewise constitute make and ordain this my last will and testament

I also bequeath unto John Montgomery and Samuel Spigner my part of the land which is in the perseession of Col. David
