IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN. I Elizabeth Brizna of Richland District and State of South Carolina being in the full possessions of all my intellectual faculties, but being old, and believeing that my body must, at no distant period, dissolve and decay- do make and ordain this my last will Testament in manner and form following -- First My Soul I commend to God- my body I desire decently intered- In relation to my Estate both real and personal, all of which having been acquired during the period of my widowhood-I give and devise in manner, following Viz. First I desire my Just debts to be paid-Item I-give and devise to my beloved Son Francis Brizna, Fifty acres, of land on which I now reside, bounded on the West, by Jas. Rivers land and on all other Sides. by lands of Jas. Douglass Senr. I give and devise also to my Son Francis, all my right interest and title, to four hundred acros of land in Fairfield District originally granted to Simon Kelly. The Said tracts of land to be held by the Said Francis and the lawful issue of his body forever --- but should my Son Francis die leaving no lawful child or children living at the time of his death, in that case I desire all the Estate herein given to him, to vest in my grand Son William Griffin I give and bequeath to my Son Fnancis in fee Simple. the following negroes Viz. one negro woman, named Rhody one negro girl, Derinder, and one negro boy, named Ishmael To be held and possessed by Said Francis and the lawful issue his body- but Should Said Francis die leaving no lewful child or children living at the time of his death-then and in that case I direct The aforesaid, negroes to be equally divided between my grand Son Wm. Griffin and my Daughter Bethenia Faust -- I give and bequeath to my Son Francis Feat or beds and furniture all my House hold and kitchen.

furniture all my stock and personal property of every de-

oription. except that herein after given item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Charlotte Griffin one megro girl named Rachael for the use and benefit of Sd. charlotte during the term of her natural life at her death to be held and possess'd by William Griffin and the lawful issue of his body. Item I give to my grand Son William Griffin one Feather bed and one Cow and Calf --- Item I give and beginth to my Daughter Bethenia Faust; one negro girl, named Claussa for the use and benefit of Said Bethenia during the term of natural her/life at her death to be possess'd and enjoyed by my grand Daughter Sarah Faust Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved Son Francis Briznan, and my friend C.

revoking and makeing void all former Wills and Lagacies by me heretofore made In testimony where of I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 18th day of October anno domini 1829.
