and my Body I Commit to the Earth to be buried in decent
christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors hereaf-
ter named, and as Touching Such worldly Estate as it hath
pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and dis-
pose of the Same in the following manner & form that is to
say first it is my will & desire that my funeral charges
and all my just debts be paid

1 Item I give and bequeath to my Beloved Son Herman Kinsler
my negro man named Jesse forever-

2 I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Mary Coon my ne-
gro woman nancy for Ever

3 I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Elizabeth
Smith my four negroe girl children named dilla & Lidia Rose
& Queen for Ever

4 Item I will that all my other property be Sold Such as my
Horses Cattle Sheep household firneture & plantation Tools
& my hogs & poultry and the money thence arising to be e-
qually divided between my four daughters Mary Coon Eliza-
beth Smith Sophia Rawls & Christina mitchel Share and Share
about.

5 Item I will that two of those negroe girls above Bequeath-
ed to my daughter Elizabeth Smith namely Lidia and Rose be
valued and that Elizabeth Smith Shall pay the value of
them two negroe children to my two daughters in the western
country named Sophia Rawls and Christina Mitchel Equilly
Share and share about

6 and I do hereby constitute and appoint my Son Herman Kinsler and my Son in law John Smith and my grandson John Smith Executors of this my Last will and Testament hereby Revoking and making void all former wills, and do Declare this my Last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 4th day of April 1817 and of American Independence the x x x x 1.
